INCIDENT ACTION PLAN

Sulphur Mines Dome – Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana

Purpose and Scope-- This Incident Action Plan (IAP) establishes the procedures and resources to be used in the event of a surface expression resulting from the failure or suspected failure of any brine cavern operated by Westlake 2 US, LLC at the Sulphur Mines Dome in Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana

Emergency Reporting and Notification Procedures
